To all whom it may concern Be it known that I Benjamin Budget a freeman of colour of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations in the amount of money as also in further consideration of five dollars current money now in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and set free a yellow woman named Steph aged about sixty two years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, which said yellow woman named Steph I purchased of a certain William Marriott of the City of Annapolis,
